WFWP International World Summit in Seoul, Korea

On 11 August, WFWP International held a world summit in Seoul, Korea, in the Convention Hall of the Kim Koo Museum and Library. The program introduced the WFWP movement in North America and South America. WFWP International President, Prof. Yeon Ah Moon, delivered the opening remarks and Dr. Lan Young Moon of Women's Peace Initiative and GWPNI gave the congratulatory message.

A few days later, on 13th August, a meeting of WFWP International was held at Chung Shim Academy. Each regional chapter made a report on their activities, and the meeting served as a forum to share ideas and best practices, as well as to facilitate possible future collaborations within each region.

WFWP HK initiated a project to send goods to Brazil for charity use; this project will be kicked off in the fourth quarter of 2014.
